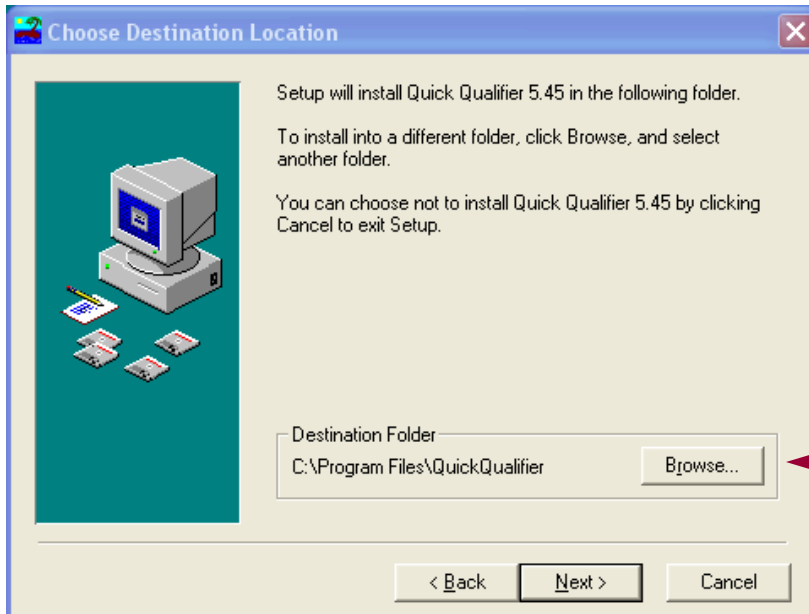
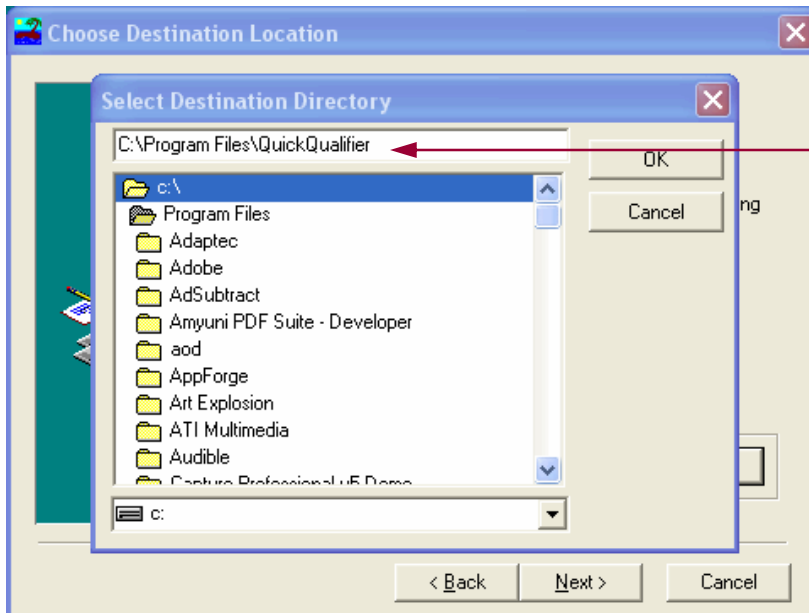


How to install Quick Qualifier a second time - part 1

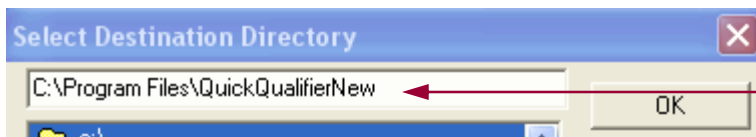


Step 1. After installing the program once, re-start the installation process. The easiest way is to simply open your disc drive and closed it again. Only this time, when you get to the second install screen, Click on **Browse**.



Step 2. You will see the default application folder named C:\Program Files\QuickQualifier

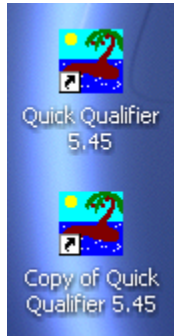
You will see the default application folder named C:\Program Files\QuickQualifier



Step 3. Now change the name of the folder by adding New or whatever you want to use to re-name the target folder.

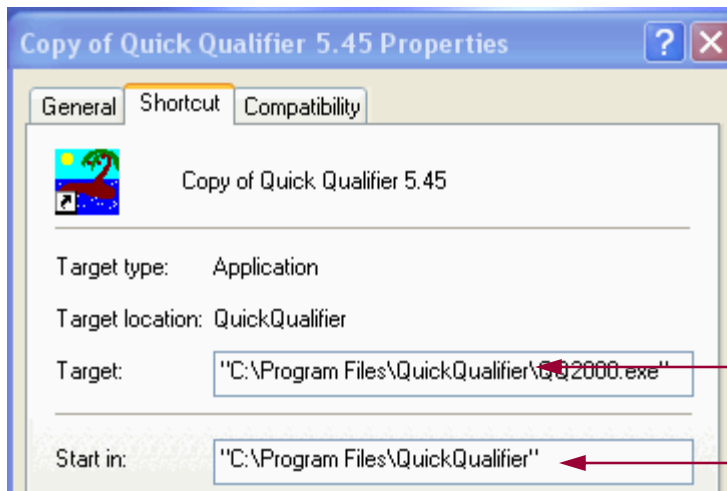
Step 4. Now just click OK and continue with the installation. There will be two separate programs installed. However, you will only see one desktop shortcut (Icon). So part two will explain how to make a second shortcut and point it to the new program.

How to install Quick Qualifier a second time - part 2:

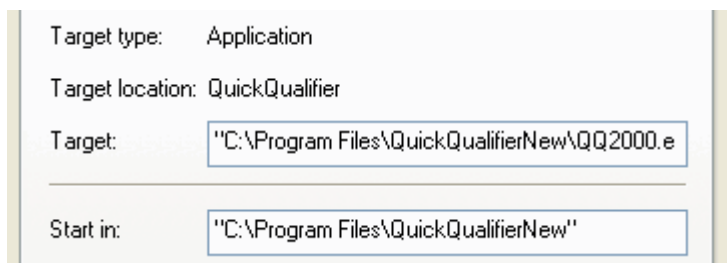


Step 1. Make a copy of the first shortcut. This is easy. Just right-click on it and select Copy.

Then put your cursor next to it and right click again. This time select Paste. You will see this.



Step 2. Now right-click on the new shortcut and select properties. You will see this screen. Put your cursor here and here and add New to both the Target: and Start in:



It should look like this. You don't have to use New. Just be sure and make the new Target and Start in match your new folder.

Step 3. Click OK and the copy will now point to the second installation. A nice final touch is to rename the second shortcut. This is also easy. Just right-click on it and select Rename.

You can install as many copies as you like. The big files are all shared in the Windows system so it uses minimal hard drive space. Good luck!
